ACID RAIN forms when clean rain comes into contact with pollutants in the air, like SULFUR DIOXIDE (SO₂), CARBON DIOXIDE (CO₂), and NITROGEN OXIDES (NO_x). Although sulfur dioxide and carbon dioxide occur in the air naturally, burning fossil fuels adds more of these chemicals to the air.

Learning About Acid Rain - US EPA

One form of pollution is acid rain. Acid rain is any form of rain that is more acidic than normal (with a pH lower than 5.6). Pure water has a pH of 7, normal rainfall has a pH of a bit less than 7, but acid rain can have a pH of about 5.0-5.5, and even in the 4 range in the northeastern United States.
