Understanding the Stages of Child Development

Child development refers to the physical, cognitive, emotional and social growth that occurs throughout a child and young person's life. Children's mental health - their cognitive, behavioural and social wellbeing - is affected by this development, as well as a range of factors, including trauma and abuse. All aspects of children's health and development work together to form their overall wellbeing.

Development is how your child grows physically and emotionally and learns to communicate, think and socialise. Children's early experiences and relationships in the first five years of life are critical for development. In the early years, your child's main way of learning and developing is through play.

Development Most children begin school at five because it is by this age that children have developed enough autonomy to be able to pay attention, concentrate well and be away from the home for extended periods of time but some children may still struggle with certain aspects as it is a big transition emotionally.

Child development between 5-6 years of age

Returning a child home from care. For many children, returning home from care is the best possible outcome. But research shows that for others this can result in further abuse or neglect (Holmes, 2014). Many children end up back in care, and a significant number move back and forth between care and their family.
