Example #2. In 2018, a 4-year collective bargaining agreement was reached between the United Steelworkers (USW) and United States Steel Corp (USSC). As per the agreement, each member will be given a signing bonus of \$4,000, 14% wage hike over the next 4 years and increased pension benefits.

After the creation of the federal Steel Labor Relations Board in late June 1935 (an independent labor relations board created by President Franklin D. Roosevelt because of the failures of the National Labor Board), Green worked with Tighe, steel industry executives and the steel board to create a plan to allow collective bargaining in the steel industry. The talks dragged on through the end of the year.

Bargaining coverage is high. The National Mediation Office (Medlingsinstitutet), which was set up in 2000, reports that 88% of employees are covered by collective bargaining, with 83% coverage in the private sector and 100% in the public sector. 1. In India, collective bargaining has been growing along with the growth of trade unions and the first collective bargaining agreement was made in a textile industry in Ahmedabad. Collective bargaining has been growing rapidly in the post-independence scenario, happening mostly at the plant and organizational level and not at the industry level.
