What are New Religious Movements? Despite the wonderfully concise meaning that Stark and Bainbridge assign it, the word cult remains an emotionally loaded term burdened with negative imagery. For this reason many writers have adopted the convention of calling contemporary groups, identified as either cults or sects, new religious movements (NRM's), or new religions.

This has led to the development of typologies of cults and other New Religious Movements. According to Roy Wallis (1984) cults differ from sects in that they are individualised, loosely-organised, tolerant and make very few demands on their adherents. This is almost the opposite of what we tend to mean by cult in popular usage and popular culture. For Wallis, cults do not claim to have found the truth, nor do they condemn those who are not part of their group.

From the 1940s the Christian countercult movement has opposed some sects and new religious movements, and it labelled them as cults for their unorthodox beliefs.
