Two types of citations are included: In-text citations are used when directly quoting or paraphrasing a source. They are located in the body of the work and contain a fragment of the full citation.

How Harvard Referencing Works There are two stages to referencing sources using the Harvard system. Firstly, you need to cite the source in the body of your work, at the point where you're referring to it. This is called the in-text citation.
