Intelligence, in terms of the Army definition of the word, means information from credible and reliable sources that is suitable for assessment and interpretation, leading to gaining an understanding of the dispositions of enemy forces, their capability and intention. The British Army formed intelligence organisations as and when required, generally during a military campaign.
