Romans 1:18-32 (10/31/14) ¶Man is a religious being, and if he refuses to let God have the place of preeminence that is rightfully His, then he will put something or someone in God's place¶ (Harrison, EBC, 23). With the rejection of God, man has nowhere to go but down. There are seven steps in the process of men's degradation. 1.

~~I. CONDEMNATION THE WRATH OF GOD REVEALED (1:18-3:20) A.~~

READ Romans 1:18-20 There are a couple of things we must understand about God's wrath. First, we need to understand that God's wrath is aimed at sin. Verse 18 tells us that ¶The wrath of God is being revealed against all the GODLESSNESS (ungodliness) and WICKEDNESS (unrighteousness) of men.¶

~~The Unrighteousness of the Gentiles ¶ Romans 1:18-32 ...~~

In 1:18-23 we have seen the basis for God's wrath on the Gentiles and any other person who acts accordingly. In short, people suppress the obvious knowledge of God in creation¶a fact which places them under his wrath. In 1:24-32 we will see how he has carried out his wrath against people who suppress his existence, power, and divine nature.
