The Scotch Gambit is a completely sound gambit that's been played by top grandmasters such as Grischuk, Carlsen or Radjabov. It often transitions into the Two Knights Defense or the Giuoco Piano. All variations where black keeps the extra pawn in the Scotch Gambit are favorable for white.

While the Scotch Game can be one of the slower games and can lead to very unexciting matches, the Scotch Gambit takes it to the other extreme as both sides have the opportunity to give up material early on in exchange for a non-material, yes crucial, advantage.

The Scotch Gambit is an exciting opening for white to choose, immediately placing the bishop on its most active diagonal and not being afraid to sacrifice a pawn! If aggressive, classical chess appeals to you, you might want to check out this opening.

Scotch Gambit - Chess Pathways

The Scotch Gambit is another off-shoot of the Scotch Game. Instead of recapturing the pawn on d4 immediately, or offering a gambit immediately with 4.c3, White develops the f1-bishop to c4, eyeing f7, and keeps Black guessing as to whether c2-c3 or Nf3xd4 will follow.

If you don't know this trap, you should! Here your task is to convert an extra piece, but first, you need to force the win of a piece by using the weak point f7.

The Scotch Gambit is an element of surprise. Instead of taking back on d4, which, as we will soon see, is the most natural move in the position, White sacrifices a pawn. However, surprising your opponent is not the only aim of this gambit: there is clear logic behind it.

A gambit is generally recognized chess term that refers to any chess opening in which one side sacrifices material (usually a pawn) in order to achieve an advantageous position.
