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How To Teach Kids To Read 1. Read Aloud to your child. Teaching your child to read is truly a process that begins at infancy. No, I am most certainly NOT advocating programs that claim to teach your baby to read using flashcards! What I AM encouraging you to do is to begin reading with your newborn within days of welcoming her home!

How To Teach A Child to Read In 10 Easy Steps - I Can ...

Read to children from books with easy-to-read large print. Use stories that have predictable words in the text. Use "big books" to help children notice and learn to recognize words that occur frequently, such as a, the, is, was, and you. Label objects in your classroom.
